Activities of the branch up to now

In 2003 a new branch of the Ian Donald School was established in Hungary, where obstetric and gynecologic ultrasound examinations have a long history. The Hungarian Society of Ultrasound in Obstetrics and Gynecology, established in 1992 organizes four postgraduate courses every year, with an average of 100 participants, and holds the Society's National Congress every 2 years for almost 1000 registered participants. Each year a course of the Hungarian Branch of Ian Donald School has been organized in Budapest (till 2019 altogether seventeen) about an update on recent developments in the field of obstetrics, gynecology and clinical genetics.
